Farm Assistance and Recovery Mission (FARM): To help farm families through this difficult time, North Carolina Farm Bureau's Hurricane Relief Fund is offering FARM. The purpose of the program is to provide assistance to eligible farmers who suffered crop losses from Hurricane Florence and Tropical Storm Michael.

Producers impacted by Hurricane Florence and Tropical Storm Michael, in the counties identified below, may request direct assistance. Qualifying producers will receive assistance based on the total number of producers who participate in the assistance program, subject to the availability of funds. The assistance provided will not exceed \$500 per producer.
